WHY WAS IT SO VITAL FOR YOU TO RUN ESTEEM DESIGNZ PROGRAM IN YOUR SCHOOL?

Sheree is passionate about girls recognising their intrinsic value and liking themselves for being simply who they are. Sheree says, she "saw the immense value in facilitating a program that would be inclusive of all the Year 5 and 6 girls and would create opportunities for the girls to appreciate the diversity of others...

WHAT WERE THE GIRL'S REACTIONS WHEN YOU GAVE THEM THE KITS AT SCHOOL?

"Our girls were VERY excited!!! Some comments were, "Is that for me?", "I love it" and "Thanks so much". I loved being able to be part of their excitement and to be able to provide such a life-affirming gift. As the girls investigated the contents, they loved the materials and many pulled out the Clue Cards and Encouragement Cards."

WHERE ARE YOU UP TO IN ESTEEM DESIGNZ PROGRAM?

"This week will be week 4 into the program and beginning stage 2. I love how flexible this program is and that because the materials are supplied with the kits my focus in facilitating is about building relationships and ensuring the girls feel heard and acknowledged. The girls are looking forward to creating a part of this stage and we have had discussion around difficulties they have faced or are facing. This has also been an opportunity for them to identify with and encourage each other."

WHAT HAS BEEN SOME OF YOUR FAVOURITE MOMENTS FROM ESTEEM DESIGNZ SO FAR?

"I love that there is **potential for new relationships** and **friendships** outside of the separate Year 5 and 6 groupings, and that the girls are beginning to **appreciate various characteristics of themselves and others**. They have started to see that different is not bad and that there are **strengths to being different** than someone else. In a transition to high school, I am confident that the journey of Esteem Designz will **continue to scaffold and support their sense of self** and in **developing friendships** and **negotiating change**."

WHAT HAVE YOU STARTED TO SEE IN THE GIRLS THAT YOU ARE EXCITED TO CONTINUE GROWING?

"I love seeing their joy and willingness to give something new a try i.e. the design projects a go and how some girls will assist others if they are experiencing difficulty. I've seen the girls encourage each other and I love that they genuinely look forward to spending this time together. I am looking forward to continuing this journey with the girls this term..."

HOW DID YOU FUND THE PROGRAM?

"After viewing the **Esteem Designz funding resources online**, and getting **advice and information directly** from them, I wrote a **sponsorship letter** and sent it out to 8 or so different local clubs / sponsorship bodies, grant suppliers. E.g. United Services Club, Tradies, Golf Club, Lioness, Lions Club, Rotary Club, Club [suburb]...

I then **followed the letter up** with an email (attaching the letter), and a phone call."

To whom it may concern,

I am contacting you as the your role at your **organisation / school** (e.g. school chaplain at **Bonnet Bay Public School**). As a/the your role (e.g. chaplain), my role is to support the social and emotional well-being of the school community. It is imperative that each child feels safe, supported and has a sense of belonging. From this connected community, students have the potential to thrive.

I would like to invite you to consider partnering with your **organisation / school** (e.g. **Bonnet Bay Public School**) with the implementation of **Esteem Designz**, a program designed specifically for teenage girls, empowering them to be confident in their identity, know their value and worth, and equip them with skills and tools to flourish in life.

Both experience and research indicate that many teenagers are becoming discontent and detached from life, and that one in five suffer from emotional or behavioural problems with little or no intervention or treatment, resorting to self-destructive ways to deal with life (Group 2009).

Studies also show that to effectively respond to the problems teenagers are facing, the underlying issue must be addressed, that of low self esteem, the primary origin of all problematic behaviours (Candito 1996).

Low self esteem can lead to disappointment, loneliness, the inability to cope with change and challenges in life, self destructive behaviours - exclusion, depression, anxiety, suicide, eating disorders, violent behaviour, substance abuse, careless or pressured sexual activity, poor social skills and relationships, joblessness, a lack of motivation, poor mental and physical health and more.

75% of girls suffering from low self-esteem are engaging in self-destructive behaviours, depression, self-harm and even suicide.

Esteem Designz aims to be a solution to these issues, imparting self-worth, self-confidence, identity, self-awareness and self-belief – the foundations to navigate the challenging developmental years, as well as equip them with practical life skills and tools to help them to endure and thrive through life's challenges.

Esteem Designz empowers girls to effectively engage in the society around them, modelling and encouraging others to develop the strategies they themselves have applied.

It can play a key role in supporting the Personal Development strand of the PDHPE curriculum in addition to strengthening resilience, friendships, and social skills in promoting unity, appreciating diversity, leadership skills and helping the girls respect and value themselves and those around them.



Utilising creativity, the program covers 5 different carefully focused stages, each designed to engage, equip and empower girls. These design projects are expressive and practical tools / coping strategies that the girls can continue to use throughout life. Each girl receives a beautifully packaged resource kit containing a Reflective journal, Clue Cards for life, Encouragement cards, the Instructions booklet for each of the main design projects of which all materials are supplied. This resource kit itself places value and affirms the girls participating in **Esteem Designz**.

70% of girls believe that they are not good enough or don't measure up in some way.

A common theme that resonates within our community is the ever-increasing issues and pressures girls are facing, including the deceiving messages of perfectionism through the media, constant comparison, peer pressure, unrealistic expectations, girls feeling inadequate, lacking confidence and self-awareness, as well as the skills to cope with the inevitable changes and challenges of life.

In my research of **Esteem Designz**, I was encouraged that psychologists, art therapists, councilors, social workers and educators have been consulted throughout the development and design of **Esteem Designz Program** to ensure the resource responsibly meets and addresses the needs of teenage girls.

I would love the opportunity to facilitate this comprehensive and uplifting program at your organisation / school (e.g. Bonnet Bay Public School) in when would you like to run the program (e.g. Term 4, 2014) and need your support to provide this tool to our who would you like to run the program with (e.g. Year 6 girls).

The cost per student is sixty dollars for the individual Girls Resource Kit that is utilised throughout the program. The total number of girls in who you want to include (e.g. Year 6) is number of girls (e.g. eighteen (18)). We also need to purchase the Facilitator's Manual that costs eighty dollars. The shipping cost for these resources is cost of shipping (e.g. thirty dollars).

As such the total amount would be total cost (e.g. \$1190.00).
